**Tenure-Track Faculty Position**

The University of South Carolina College of Social Work invites applications and nominations for a tenure-track position at the rank of assistant or associate professor from candidates whose research and teaching agendas focus on health or social interventions with children, families, or older adults.

**Qualifications:** The successful candidate must have an MSW with two years of post-masters practice experience and a doctoral degree in social work or a related field; a demonstrated or promising record of transdisciplinary, community-engaged research and practice; a demonstrated or promising record of obtaining extramural funding; and the ability or experience in teaching social work practice courses, preferably with individuals, families, and groups.

**The College:** The College of Social Work is a premier setting to advance the health and social well-being of vulnerable populations through transdisciplinary, community-engaged research and teaching. Our academic offerings include BSW, MSW, and PhD programs. We affiliate closely with other health science units of the university, creating many opportunities for collaborative research with public health, medicine, pharmacy, and nursing.
