MSW degree from CSWE accredited program required. Ph.D. strongly preferred. Candidates should be able to teach across the undergraduate generalist curriculum and in a newly created MSW Program concentrating on advanced practice with diverse individuals, families, and communities. Significant practice experience is also highly desirable. Excellent teaching and an active program of scholarly activity and community service are expected.
