

**Elizabethtown College**

The Social Work Department at Elizabethtown College located in Elizabethtown, Pennsylvania will be hiring a faculty member starting August 2010. This is a 9-month, full-time, tenure track position. We are looking for a candidate with dynamic teaching skills who is able to excite students about our profession in their foundation courses as well contribute to the knowledge base of the profession. We seek someone who genuinely enjoys teaching and working with students.

We follow the Teacher-Scholar model and course workload is three 4-credit courses per semester; maximum class size is 35 students. Faculty members have the ability to teach/develop courses in their areas of expertise. Internal funds and grants are available for scholarship and professional development.

Candidates :

1. Must have an earned Doctor of Philosophy Degree in Social Work or closely affiliated field (ABD will be considered).
2. Must possess a Master of Social Work degree from a Council on Social Work Education accredited institution.
3. Must have teaching experience in higher education.
4. Must show evidence of a research agenda
5. Should have two years of post-MSW practice experience
6. Must have an area of expertise, policy is preferred

Responsibilities will include:

1. Teaching the Introduction to Social Work and Human Behavior in the Social Environment Courses in addition to upper-level courses
2. Demonstrating an increasing level of service to the department and the college
3. Developmental advising of students
4. Contributing to the knowledge base of the profession through scholarship

Finalists will be required to submit original transcripts and copies of recent course evaluations

**About the Social Work Department**

The Social Work Program at Elizabethtown College was established in 1972 and received accreditation from the Council on Social Work Education in 1977. The program has been accredited continuously since 1977. We currently have 65 majors, 4 full-time professors and 4 adjunct professors. Elizabethtown College awards a Bachelor of Arts Degree (BA) in Social Work. The Department offers courses contributing to the following minors: Women and Gender Studies, Human Services, International Studies and Peace and Conflict Studies.
