Program Director, South Bend Campus

The Indiana University School of Social Work invites applications for Program Director on the IU South Bend campus in north-central Indiana. This is a twelve month position with primary responsibility for program administration with some teaching, research, and external service duties. The position requires that the candidate be qualified to be appointed with tenure at the rank of Associate or Full Professor. The successful candidate will be in residence in South Bend, but will be expected to travel for meetings to Indianapolis and other School program sites

Essential qualifications include: An earned doctorate in social work or a related field; an MSW with at least three years of post-MSW practice experience; at least three years administrative experience in a social work education setting; a teaching, research and publication record sufficient to meet criteria for tenure; command of CSWE accreditation standards; demonstrated excellence in public relations; excellent written and oral communication skills; and, demonstrated skill in curriculum development and academic program monitoring and evaluation. Grant writing experience is desirable.

This position will begin July 1, 2010. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The Indiana University School of Social Work (IUSSW), headquartered in Indianapolis, has a long and distinguished history that began in 1911. IUSSW offers the BSW, MSW and PhD in Social Work and the AS and BS in Labor Studies. The School has approximately 65 full-time faculty members on seven campuses with five faculty members in residence in South Bend. The School enrolls nearly 1,500 students in its programs statewide with approximately 125 part-time MSW students on the South Bend campus. At the present time, the Mental Health and Addictions Concentration is the only MSW option at this campus location. However, based on potential demand, the School anticipates expanding program offerings in South Bend at the MSW and BSW levels.

Indiana University South Bend is a comprehensive state institution with 7700 students and 292 full-time faculty serving the urban, suburban, and rural communities of north central Indiana and southwestern Michigan. The cost of living compares favorably with other regions in the country.
