POSITION TITLE & DESCRIPTION: The Department of Social Work invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track appointment at the rank of Associate or Assistant Professor in our MSW Program beginning Fall 2010. The successful candidate will be qualified to teach in core curricular areas including research and social work practice with individuals and families. Expectations for the position include: teaching; developing and maintaining an active research agenda; advising students; serving on University, College, and Department committees; and developing a record of professional service in the greater community. This position is contingent upon the availability of authorized funding.

MINIMUM

QUALIFICATIONS:

A Ph. D. and Master of Social Work Degree required. Other minimum qualifications include

- Two years post-MSW practice experience
- Demonstrated ability, interest, and active involvement in scholarly activity
- Experience in curriculum development
- Commitment to the pursuit of social justice
- Commitment to empowerment and strengths-based social work practice
- Ability to work across multiple systems and with diverse populations

In addition to the above, candidates for the Associate level would have an additional 3 years post-MSW practice experience (total 5 years) and five years teaching experience preferably in a graduate social work program. The candidates would have a developed research agenda and experience in curriculum development.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A potential candidate's consideration will be enhanced by providing evidence of understanding and experience with the Council on Social Work Education standards as they relate to social work education and practice.

HOW TO APPLY & DEADLINE:

A complete application must include: an application letter, specifically addressing the position description and qualifications; unofficial photocopies of graduate transcripts; a professional résumé, including the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of three references. Official transcripts will be required at the time of hire.

Screening of completed application files will begin on December 1, 2009. The position will remain open until filled. This appointment begins Fall 2010.
