Monmouth University School of Social Work MSW and BSW Faculty Position

Monmouth University's School of Social work invites applications for one faculty position to begin in September, 2010. This is a one-year, non-tenure track, renewable contract (up to 5 years).

Position: Specialist Professor of Social Work

Starting Date: Fall Semester 2010

Minimum Qualifications: Completed MSW; eligible for New Jersey social work licensure. Full time BSW and/or MSW teaching experience preferred. At least five years post MSW Social Work experience preferred with an expertise in micro and/or macro social work. Demonstrated evidence of maintaining professional currency and ability to develop new curriculum; excellent communicator; collegial work style and a commitment to advocate for the interests of the School and the profession. The successful candidate will have a demonstrated commitment to social justice and human rights.

Duties: Teaching across the curriculum in both BSW and MSW courses, in foundation, practice and elective courses. Assisting the School in meeting all aspects of CSWE reaccreditation guidelines, advising students, collaborating on School issues and committees.

The University: Monmouth is a private non sectarian university located in West Long Branch, New Jersey. The University is located less than one mile from the Atlantic Ocean, and one and one half hours from either New York City or Philadelphia. The student body is diverse. Although most students come from New Jersey, 19 States and 35 nations are represented.

The School of Social Work has maintained an accredited BSW Program since 1975 and in Fall 1998 began its MSW Program (accredited 2000) with concentrations in International and Community Development and Clinical Practice with Families and Children.
